VISION

STRATEGY

Our strategy is to help every student who attends Calvary Students to:

BELONG - give every student a place where they know they belong and matter

- Feel that CS gatherings and experiences are warm and welcoming.
- Feel like CS is a safe place to talk about anything.
- Feel seen, named, and known by their small group leaders.
- Feel like Small Group is family and a place they can be real.
- Feel that the community of the church is like being home.

BELIEVE - equip every student to develop an authentic lifelong faith and identity in Jesus

- Have a clear understanding of the gospel.
- Articulate their OWN personal story and faith in Jesus.
- Know that CS is a safe place to ask any questions or express doubts.
- By giving clear next steps and tools on how to grow an everyday faith.
- Develop a love for Jesus that leads to a lifelong faith.

BECOME - help every student discover their purpose and become more like Jesus by living out their faith

- Have an active and engaged faith that serves others.
- Understand that there is a world bigger than themselves.
- Have a clear understanding of the purpose that God has created them for.
- Use their spiritual gifts to impact the people around them.
- Prioritize Jesus as the center of their life.

WHAT ARE SOME ROLES ON THE SUPPORT TEAM?

There are lots of ways to get involved and help serve at CMS/CHS. Maybe there is something that you are passionate about that isn't on this list? Let us know! We will definitely find a way to use your passion at CS. Here is a list of some areas and teams you can serve on:

SET UP / TEAR DOWN TEAM

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 times a month

Come to CMS/CHS a little early or stay a little late to help set up and tear down.

SET DESIGN TEAM

Time Commitment: bi-monthly

Work on designing engaging sets for our stage for our different teaching series throughout the year.

WELCOME TEAM

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 times a month

Welcome students at the door with a big smile and help them get checked in. Show them how to find their way around and introduce them to some new people.

HOST TEAM

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 times a month

Help host on stage by sharing announcements, leading crowd games and helping every student feel excited to be at CMS/CHS.

FOOD SERVICES TEAM

Time Commitment: Once a month

Prepare delicious snacks for students to enjoy conversation around!

TECH TEAM

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 times a month

Help run video, lights, and sound to create an engaging experience for students while we are in the Student Space.

WORSHIP BAND

Time Commitment: Every Other Week

Use the musical talents God has given you to help lead students in worship together.

SOCIAL MEDIA TEAM

Time Commitment: 1 to 4 times a month

Highlight what an awesome time we had at CMS/CHS by posting pictures, videos, and stories from CS on Instagram/Facebook.

COMMUNICATOR TEAM

Time Commitment: As needed

Help students understand what God's Word says by teaching during our large group time.
